- A request was made to move "Pass the Hat and Match" membership funds to a student's OR pledges, the board will graciously decline this request due to potential accounting and fundraising conflicts
- There was one negative parent email regarding OR that included many valid points and considerations, Leonie addressed the concerns with great consideration, Kristi suggested revisiting the open Fundraising position to clearly itemize responsibilities and find ways to make the position more appealing or palpable

Board Updates:

Membership/Zoe G

- At 74%, in line with last year; activity has slowed considerably and we don't anticipate an uptick without promotional efforts
- Currently contest for 1st class per grade level to reach 100% gets a popsicle party
- Jen and Zoe to draft bullets for parents to share with families on classroom benefits from PTSA funds, Mrs. Sterrett has good messages she shares on Haiku
- Jen and Zoe to co-author newsletter article on district and state PTSA allocations
- Kristi has funds for staff and families in need, considering approach for outreach (discussed providing staff first, then inform counselor of membership funds available or post on PTSA board, "there are funds for families in need, can contact Zoe")
- We are on our way for membership awards, there is potential to gain higher recognition.
- Zoe strongly recommends higher promotional push of PTSA,
 - group agreed to pursue Mr. Hedin's idea to use an entry PTSA bulletin board for headshots and group picture with empty "silhouette" for open positions
 - We'll time refreshed promotion around new bulletin board, January, 2015
 - Kristi will look into rules around membership match
